The Rotary Club of Spartanburg has chosen to place a Verdin four faced clock in Downtown Spartanburg to celebrate the Club's 100^{th} Anniversary. The City of Spartanburg supports the placement of the clock on the corner of East Main and Liberty Streets. The cost is \$30,000.

The clock that has been selected is a 12'8" in height with 28" dials and is known as Verdin's Howard Replica/Seth Thomas (Model 4M/STII). This clock is similar to the one selected by the Rotary Club of Lexington (SC) which is shown below. Paint color is black.
