THE ROTARY CLUB OF SPARTANBURG CENTENNIAL CLOCK April 1, 1916 – April 1, 2016

The Rotary Club of Spartanburg has chosen to place a Verdin four faced clock in Downtown Spartanburg to celebrate the Club's 100th Anniversary. The City of Spartanburg supports the placement of the clock on the corner of East Main and Liberty Streets. The cost is \$30,000.

The clock that has been selected is a 12'8" in height with 28" dials and is known as Verdin's Howard Replica/Seth Thomas (Model 4M/STII). This clock is similar to the one selected by the Rotary Club of Lexington (SC) which is shown below. Paint color is black.
