Dr. Russell Booker gave a presentation on new plans for schools in District 7. The Capital Improvement Concept being considered replaces Spartanburg High School with a new campus that could open in the Fall of 2019. In the current proposal, the site of the new high school would be on 182 acres on East Main Street near Home Depot. A new elementary school would replace two current elementary schools, Chapman and Houston in the Drayton area to open in the Fall of 2018. And the current high school would be remodeled to become McCracken Middle School, which would open in the Fall of 2020.
